

Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS)

The Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) is the primary postsecondary education data collection program for NCES. IPEDS is a single, comprehensive system designed to encompass all institutions and educational organizations whose primary purpose is to provide postsecondary education. The IPEDS system is built around a series of interrelated surveys to collect institution-level data in such areas as enrollments, program completions, faculty, staff, and finances.

1. Select: **IPEDS Peer Analysis System**. *Enables a user to compare an institution of the user's choosing to a group of peer institutions.*
2. Select: **Institution level**. *Allows access to adjudicated data.*
3. The user will be prompted with the NCES data usage agreement. *Please read carefully.*
4. Enter the University of Oregon's unitid (209551) for the user ID and password.
5. Under the Peer Analysis system, select the button "Use My Institution."
6. In the upper right-hand corner, select the link "Reports and Stats."
7. In the list of items, select **Forms Facsimile**.
8. Select: **View reports for a selected institution**.
9. You will be presented with a list of surveys submitted by the University of Oregon.
